Letter from Nehemiah Jewett of Rowley, Massachusetts to Maximillian Jewett of Canaan, Maine, dated December 8, 1788. Transcription:

Dear Brother + Sister

These lines leave me in health as I hope they will find you thru the goodness of God - but the sorfull ocasion which I rite to you - I hope will be for our good through Christ for our best good - on the 25th of Nov. Brother Joshua Burpee Departed this life. He was sick 9 or 10 Days, he died of a fever - he settled his estate as forworth. he has made me his exitour. he gave to me his sheep paster to enabel me to pay his debts and if any money should be left it is to be Divided between your wife Sister and my wife [inserted above] where I said sister your wife + mine. he gave to his widow all his personal Estate / and to her given all his real estate for her Lifetime - if she should mary she is not to hold but one thurd of the Estate + mother Burpee third, after she has Don with them is to go to yor wife + mine = the hol of the Estate after mother + sister has Don with it is to go to mine wife + yours - the Legacy, to be paid by your wife + mine is as folers, to Brother Samuel Sarls 20 dollers at term of three years, to sisters son George Jewett Abbott 150 dollers when he shall arrive at the age of 20 one; I should be Aming to keep the sheep paster and pay the debts - if you was with me so as we could agree a Boute the price, I should be glad if yould send me word whaire I shall have it as it as it is priced/ or it will be sold at a Vendue. I suppose wont be much

money left after the Debts and Charges is paid - all the money due with the sheepe paster is gone to me to pa the debts. -

my children desire to be remeber'd to your children
